July 12-14, 2010 in Caledonia, MI**

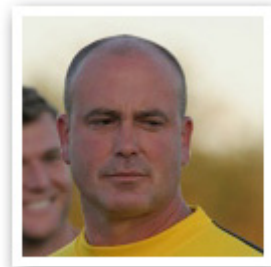

Stan Anderson has owned and operated Camp Shutout in the Milwaukee area for the past 20 years and it has become one of the most highly attended keeper camps in the nation, attracting 115 keepers to the week-long camp.

The 2nd annual West Michigan Camp Shutout Road Show returns to West Michigan July 12-14, 2010 and takes the same concepts taught at the in-residence camp and brings them here for over 13 hours of high level goalkeeper training.

The camp will be held at the South Christian Sports Complex on Kalamazoo Ave, just off 84th St. Cost for the three day camp is \$250.



At the camp, keepers are broken down into small groups and receive over 13 hours of training tailored to their current skill and ability level. There will be five sessions:

Mon (July 12): 9:00am-11:30am, 2:00pm-4:30pm
Tue (July 13): 9:00am-11:30am, 2:00pm-4:30pm
Wed (July 14): 9:00am-12:30pm

All campers receive keeper training and a camp t-shirt as well as access to a certified athletic trainer who has worked at goalkeeper camps present at all sessions.

Stan Anderson (Associate Head Coach of the Marquette University Men's Soccer Team) and his staff will lead five sessions over three days at the South Christian Sports Complex on Kalamazoo Ave, just off 84th St. On Mon/Tue (July 12 and 13), there will be a morning session and an afternoon session. On Wed (July 14), there will be a morning session only. This camp is suitable for goalkeepers of all ages, as keepers will be broken into small groups. Keepers will receive over 13 hours of training tailored to their current skill and ability level. This will ensure that every keeper will get excellent and demanding training based on their current skill level.
